



Dear Parents,

In the event that your child/children are unable to attend school in person, we have created a timetable of activities for them to complete.

We will be using the Oak National Academy as the basis for the children's learning. The Oak National Academy is an online classroom made by teachers, funded by the government to support learning during the Coronavirus Pandemic. It provides high-quality video lessons and resources covering 'The National Curriculum' objectives.

Each class will provide a timetable of lessons for the children to complete. There will be daily English and Mathematics lessons and an addition lesson each day with a scientific or PHSE (Personal Health and Social Education) focus.

The weblink for each subject can be found on the timetable and can be copied into the browser bar. Then click on the relevant lesson for that day.

Each lesson contains a video to an activity to complete. The activities vary in type and length: there could be a quiz to complete or a written task.
