## **Dear Families**

What a windy week it's been! Forest School happens in any weather but not in high winds or during lightning storms so sessions on Tuesday and Wednesday this week have been on the school site. The children have made some amazing creations with mud and straw (trenches in Kestrels and mud houses in Squirrels) and enjoyed making use of the wood chip area behind Home Lodge where we have a lovely mud kitchen (courtesy of the PTFA), digging patch, willow tunnel and pond.

#### **School Attendance:**

Everyone at Clandon believes children benefit from full school attendance. Over the past year poor attendance and punctuality have been ongoing issues for our school. This means some children are routinely missing out on important learning. When children are late to school it disrupts the learning of not only that child but the rest of their class. Our attendance policy explains that we expect all parents or carers who have day to day responsibility for children will:

- encourage daily school attendance and be aware of their legal responsibilities.
- ensure that the child in their care arrives at school punctually each day, prepared for the school day.
- contact the school on the first day of a child's absence by phone or email. We like to know the nature of the illness and the day the child is expected to be able to resume their studies.
- discuss promptly with their child's class teacher or senior staff, any problems that deter their child from attending school.
- contact the school promptly whenever any problem occurs that may keep the child away from school.
- meet with the appropriate person to discuss persistent absence.
- not take holidays in term time.

The local authority inclusion officer will continue termly visits this year and we will routinely notify parents if their child's attendance falls below 95%. Thank you in advance for your support.

### **Child Health Advice**

Many children have received their flu immunisation in school today, if parents have consented to this. Immunising young children against flu has been shown to have a significant effect in reducing the spread of the illness to older relatives as young children have a greater ability to "shed" viruses.
