# **Friendship Workshop:**



Year 6 enjoyed a workshop on friendship with The Matrix Trust. They talked about how to define friendship, making new friends, boundaries and managing conflict in friendship. The facilitators will return later in the year for a workshop focussed on transition. The Matrix Trust have designed their programmes to help prepare our Year 6 children for their upcoming transition to secondary school.

#### **School Attendance:**

We wrote about this in the newsletter before half term but wanted to update you on a visit from our School Inclusion Officer earlier this week. She did an assembly for the children on the importance of prompt arrival and regular attendance at school. School gates are open from 8.45 to 8.55am. From now on, children arriving after 9.15am will be coded as U on the register (late after registers close). This means that the session for which they arrive late is classed as an unauthorised absence.

Next **Saturday**, **11**th **November**, we are holding a Forest School Open Morning from **10.00am-12.00pm**. Please come along and if you know any families currently looking for infant or primary school places do let them know about this event too.

#### **Pantomime:**

On Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November the PTFA is generously funding ticket costs for a whole school outing to the Pantomime at the Yvonne Arnaud Theatre in Guildford. As in previous years, we will travel by coach to the theatre for which we will ask parents to pay. Collection after the show will be from the Yvonne Arnaud. We are notifying families early about this so you will be able to make arrangements to collect your child from central Guildford on 12<sup>th</sup> December. The finish time will be confirmed closer to the performance date but will be between 3.30-4pm. There will be no Active Hour or After-School Care on this day.

## Help for Families Facing Hardship at Christmas:

We know times are tough for families at the moment and Christmas brings extra challenges when wanting to buy gifts for our children. Miss McGowan has been in touch with a couple of local charities who supported some of our families last year:

- Jigsaw provides a £25 gift card for each child referred between the age of one and up to those in Yr6 at primary school. The voucher can be used at The Entertainer Toy Shop either in store or online.
- Stripey Stork provides a £15-£20 main present for children who otherwise won't get a present.


