Teaching staff had a productive training day on Tuesday discussing communication with children and parents and looking at different elements of our school development plan. On Wednesday we enjoyed all being together again, with the children excited to be back to school and share their news from Christmas and New Year.

Sportshall Events:

We will shortly be sending out letters about the Sportshall events at The Spectrum in Guildford which are organised by the Guildford Primary Schools Sports Association. As this is a very local venue we hope that parents will be able to coordindate transport so that all the children can take part in these fantastic events. On the day, the children will need to be dropped at Dorking Halls at 4pm and parents can purchase tickets to attend performance which will be later that evening (probably 7pm). Last year's event was fantastic with some lovely feedback from parents attending, staff supporting and from the children who smiled all the way through! It is such an incredible opportunity for our children to be able to perform in front of an audience of 700 people so we really hope lots of the children sign-up to represent Clandon at the event.
