Information about Free Childcare:

From April 2024, eligible working parents of 2-year-olds can access 15 hours free childcare (over 38 weeks a year) **from the term after** their child's 2nd birthday.

From 2 January 2024, eligible working parents will be able to apply for their 15 hours childcare for their two-year-old. Parents have until 31 March to apply for a code, with the best time being mid-January to the end of February, in case further information is required to support the application.
