In RE, Squirrel Class children have been learning about Judaism. They have created some beautiful Sukkahs. A Sukkah is a temporary hut topped with branches and decorated with autumnal, harvest or Judaic themes that the Jews eat, sleep and spend time in during the week-long festival of Sukkot. The Sukkah commemorates the time God provided for the Israelites in the wilderness after they were freed from slavery in Egypt. Sukkot is considered by the Jews to be a joyous time although the Sukkah symbolises the fragility of life and dependence on God.

Kestrel Class were very excited to hear that there would be a special visitor this afternoon... a rumour went round that it might be David Beckham! It wasn't – but they were just as excited to see Miss McGowan who had brought in her tortoise, Trottie. Children tried to work out how old Trottie is and count the scutes on her beautiful shell.
