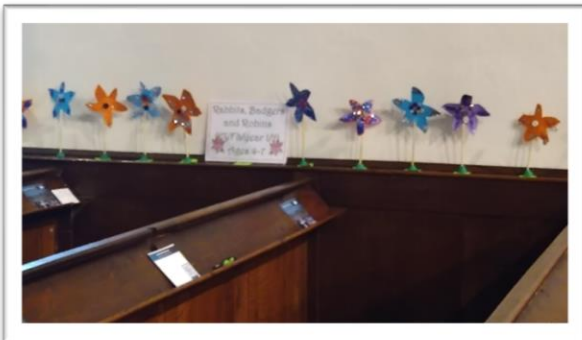
Wraparound care and clubs options from September are as follows:

<b>Breakfast Club</b>	<b>8.00-8.45am</b>	£6.00 per session for full term bookings with required days booked in advance
		£7.00 per ad hoc session
	This will offer breakfast, activities and before school care for families who need to drop off at school early.	
<b>Early Birds</b>	<b>8.30-8.45am</b>	£2.50 per session for a full term booking with required days booked in advance
		No breakfast will be provided and we will be unable to accept ad hoc bookings for Early Birds
<b>Night Owls</b>	<b>3.20-3.30pm</b>	£2.00 per session for full term bookings with required days booked in advance.
		For families who need a bit more time to collect from Clandon, eg needing to collect siblings from another school. We will be unable to accept ad hoc bookings for Night Owls.
<b>After School Club Short Session</b>	<b>3.20-4.20pm</b>	£4.00 per session for full term bookings with required days booked in advance
		£5.00 per ad hoc session
	During this session a variety of different activity clubs will be provided by school staff.	
<b>After School Club Long Session</b>	<b>3.20-5.20pm</b>	£8.00 per session for full term bookings with required days booked in advance
		£9.00 per ad hoc session
	The long session will offer the same activity clubs as the short session, followed by an hour of after school care.
