Paralympian Visit:

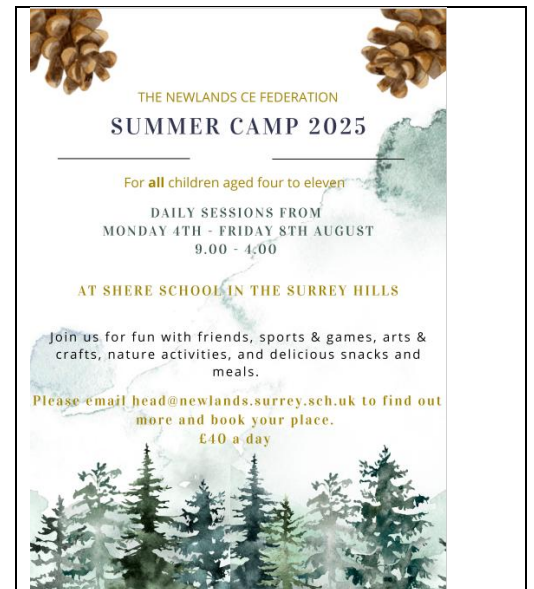

Summer Camp:

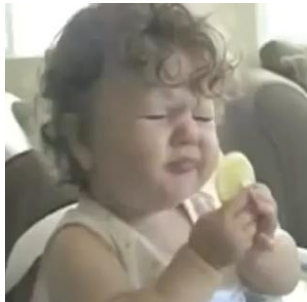
Bookings are now open for the Federation's summer holiday camp which will be running again during this year's summer holiday. Please see the flier for more information.

JOB ADVERT FOR SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL WALKING INSTRUCTORS

Surrey County Council launched the 'Feet First: Walking Training' service nearly three years ago. Training is targeted at 7–8-year-olds (pupils in Year 3) and is a service available to all primary schools across the county. The aim of 'Feet First' is to provide trainees with vital road safety skills to better enable them to safely walk to and from school with an adult and prepare them for future independent travel. It is taught through a combination of classroom and practical roadside sessions. The practical sessions are delivered by trained Walking Instructors, employed by Surrey County Council.

The job advert closes at 23:59 on 29 June 2025. However, SCC will review applications on a rolling basis and the advert may close earlier if sufficient applications are received.
