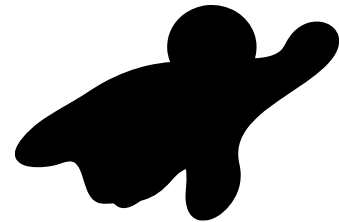

Surrey Paediatrics Parenting Service



The Paediatrics Parenting Support Service has been commissioned by Surrey Heartlands Trust to offer support to parent/carers and their families living in Surrey who are exploring the possibilities that their young person, 5 years old and younger may be neurodivergent.

Empowering parents/carers with the support and tools they need to allow their young people to thrive.

What we offer

Our service encourages parents/carers to explore the early developmental stages of young people, offer a deeper understanding into emotional regulation, explore strategies that can be used at home and shared with childcare provisions.

Our practitioners provide a 6-week group intervention, either online or face-to-face within the community with the option to bring young people along.



Referral Process

Our service accepts referrals from the community. This includes but is not limited to:

- ★ Surrey Access and Advice Team
- ★ Professionals working with the family (School, GP, Social Care)
- ★ Parents or Carers themselves
