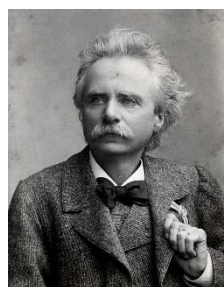
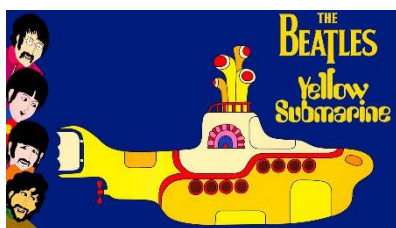
Dear Families,

Car parking reminder

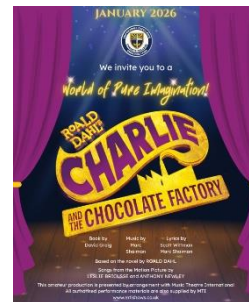
The front car park is for staff and parents/carers who are Blue Badge holders, or who have been given permission by SLT.
