Dear Families

The children have been amazing this week. Despite the heat, they have been working hard in lessons and have been following our 'Clandon Way' showing kindness and respect to each other and staff. As the hot weather continues, children are allowed to come into school wearing their PE kit, but please remember suncream, sun hat and water bottles.

Sports Day:

Sports day will now take place next **Friday, 17th July at 1.15pm**. As in previous years this will be at the West Clandon Recreation Ground. Parents are invited to arrive from 12.45pm to secure their spot and collect their salad from the PTFA (see below)! Please bring your own chair or picnic rug – it is going to be hot that day, so you may also want to bring a parasol or your own gazebo for shade.



Wendy at the West Clandon Royal British Legion has very kindly agreed to open the clubhouse so you will be able to buy drinks and use the toilets. Children may not enter the clubhouse or use the toilets unless they have adult supervision.

Children will be having lunch at school and then walking up to the recreation ground with staff for 1.15pm. They will need to **come to school in their PE kit** and have a **water bottle** with them (there will be water stations and water available from the Legion once we are up at the recreation ground).

As in previous years, the event begins with potted sports led by our Year 6s and then onto running races for each year group (and of course a parents' race!)

At the end of sports day, children can then go home from the recreation ground.

GIRLS' RUGBY TRAINING AT GUILDFORDIANS, STOKE PARK, GUILDFORD

This year Guildfordians are introducing a Girls Only Rugby Pathway for girls interested in playing full contact rugby from year 4 up to year 7. Many girls stop playing rugby at around age 8 or 9 because of the introduction of tackling at that age and the potential physical risks of contact training with boys.

Guildfordians are hoping to attract more girls to the sport and retain them for longer through encouragement of their skills and knowledge, tailored training better suited to their development, female health issues acknowledged and addressed and support in building strong friendships within the team and across the club in a safe and fair environment against peers they can relate to.

The season starts on the first Sunday in September (6th) from 10:00-12:00 at Stoke Park (everyone new to the club gets three free trial/taster sessions). The club is also running free Summer fitness and skills sessions for an hour every Sunday morning from 10:00, between now and 30th August. These sessions are for girls of all ages and experience, siblings, friends, even mums can join in if they want to. Sessions will focus on skills and conditioning, non-contact in the offseason, so won't get too technical or rule heavy. Anyone interested in seeing what it might be like to play rugby with like-minded girls is encouraged to give it a try.

Guildfordians coaches are RFU Coaching Award qualified, have DBS certification and have undertaken mandatory RFU Safeguarding, Headspace (concussion awareness) and Tackle Safe training.
